### Projects and Goals

- Students will further investigate ideas and techniques from Photography 1. Emphasis is placed on more conceptual projects, works in series, and advanced editing skills
- Students will work both by hand and digitally (using Adobe Photoshop)
- Emphasis is placed on research and consistent shooting both in and out of school as an integral part of the photographic process.
- Students are required to give informal photography presentations throughout the semester
- Professional photographers in the field will be introduced to the students and they will be encouraged to research photographers independently to aid them in informing their own projects.
- An off campus field trip is often planned for students to give students the opportunity to deeply explore photographers' works.
- Emphasis is placed on process and revision

### Grading:

Students will be evaluated on the quality of their work, effort put into their projects and participation in critiques and other classroom activities. Full classroom participation and attendance is essential for success in this class.

The final grade consists of project grades, homework shoots, and class participation.

### Homework

Shooting projects (to be completed outside of school) are assigned throughout the semester and count for a portion of a student's grade.

### Materials

- Camera (student is required to use their own camera for homework shoots)
- Tripod (optional, art department has a limited number of tripods for students use)

### Attendance

Attendance for all classes is mandatory. GNS school policy will be enforced for unexcused absences and latenesses.

### Extra Help/Extra Computer Lab Time

The classroom is available for students to work outside of class time. Teachers are available by appointment.
